



## CYC SOCCER/VOLLEYBALL PLAYOFF GUIDELINES 2018

Important information for all CYC soccer/volleyball coaches:

### DATES FOR PLAYOFFS

- November 7-11. Girls soccer playoffs.
- November 14-18. Boys soccer playoffs
- November 28<sup>th</sup>- December 2<sup>nd</sup>. Boys/girls volleyball playoffs.

Coaches: If you think your team will play in the Archdiocesan playoffs, block these dates now.

Please relay this information to your parents. Do not schedule events that may conflict with these dates. Be proactive.

### CONFLICTS

Conflicts should be submitted to the CYC office using the form on the CYC website, <http://www.cycstl.net/sports/soccer> or <http://www.cycstl.net/sports/volleyball>

The only conflicts accepted are for school or religious activities.

- Girls soccer conflicts are due October 31<sup>st</sup>.
- Boys soccer conflicts are due November 7<sup>th</sup>.
- Volleyball conflicts are due November 14<sup>th</sup>.

Any conflicts submitted after these dates will be subject to a \$50.00 fee charged to your Athletic Association. **This rule will be enforced.**

Any team forfeiting or dropping out of the Archdiocesan playoffs after the playoff meeting on Monday will be assessed a fee of \$250.00 charged to your Athletic Association. **This rule will be enforced.**

## **PRE-PLAYOFF MEETING**

All teams entering the Archdiocesan playoffs must have a representative at the pre-playoff meeting. **Teams without a representative at the meeting will be removed from the playoffs and charged the forfeiture fee.**

- Girls soccer playoff meeting, Monday November 5<sup>th</sup>, 6:30 pm.
- Boys soccer playoff meeting, Monday November 12<sup>th</sup>, 6:30 pm.
- Volleyball playoff meeting, Monday November 19<sup>th</sup>, 6:30 pm.

All playoff meetings are held at the Rigali Center in the Fleur de Lis Room.

We hope the entire experience of playing in the Archdiocesan playoffs is fun and rewarding for you, your parents and your team. This season we are hoping to avoid the problem of last minute conflicts. The key is getting this information to your parents, not once, but frequently during the season.
