St Charles District Disciplinary Guidelines

The following guidelines are the basis for disciplinary decisions from the Hearing Board. Actual reported circumstances may change the guideline to be more or less severe. Suspensions are served with the next PLAYED game(s).

ANY EJECTION IS AN AUTOMATIC MINIMUM ONE GAME/MATCH SUSPENSION

<u>VIOLATION</u>	<u>1ST OFFENSE</u>	<u>2ND OFFENSE</u>
FIGHTING- physical altercations between players, coaches, spectators	4 games	8 games
STRIKING- or attempting to strike and opponent, colleague, spectator, an Official	2 games 1 year	4 games 5 years
THROWING - objects at an opponent, colleague, spectator coach, manager, an Official	2 games 6 games	4 games 1 year
SPITTING- Same as Throwing		
VERBAL THREATS- harm towards opponent, colleague, spectator, coach/mgr an Official	2 games 4 games	4 games 1 year
FOUL/ABUSIVE- language at an opponent, colleague, spectator, coach/mgr an Official	1 game 3 games	3 games 6 games
EJECTION- of a Manager or Coach by an official in Pre-K thru 4 th grade games	5 game minimum	1 year
CYBER BULLYING- in appropriate content placed on social media/websites	3 game minimum	1 year

Participating in a game(s) while under suspension:

A player will receive an additional 4 games suspension- the team will forfeit the game.

A Coach/Manager who allows a suspended player(s) to participate- 4 games and team will forfeit.

A Coach/Manager who participates while under suspension- 6 games additional

Illegal Player(s): Upon proof of participation- player(s) will be suspended for an equal number of games as those played for up to 30 days prior to the infraction. The team will forfeit all the games that the player(s) participated in. A manager may be disciplined in a similar manner.

Disciplinary decision may have a period of time and/or a number of games for suspensions; and may be accompanied with probation. During a probation periods, violation will result in disciplinary decisions that are generally more severe than the guidelines suggest. Suspension carry forward to succeeding sport seasons until the total time or games have been completed.

The St Charles District reserves the right to discipline coaches, managers, spectators, players, & officials, as it deems necessary for the purpose of upholding the Constitution and polices of the Catholic Youth Council and St Charles District.
